



The **National Network of State Adolescent Health Coordinators (NNSAHC)** unites those designated as state adolescent health coordinators (SAHCs), and others responsible for coordinating adolescent health program direction in state Title V/maternal and child health programs, and other programs in state public health agencies.

To provide leadership for the improvement of adolescent health and youth development by informing, consulting and advocating with stakeholders across the nation.

NNSAHC's **volunteer leadership team** is comprised of adolescent health coordinators from MN, MA, NM, AZ, CO, FL, and MO who serve in 1-3 year terms as officers and regional members-at-large.

In States

NNSAHC welcomes, orients and provides mentorship opportunities for new SAHCs.

NNSAHC provides electronic forums for connecting SAHCs with each other and with national and federal resource partners.

NNSAHC conducts assessments of SAHCs and Title V/MCH adolescent health programs every 2-3 years since 1996 to create a profile of adolescent health efforts in states under the leadership of SAHCs, connect state peers around common interests and issues and identify their emerging needs for technical assistance and training.

In the Field

Serving in advisory capacities on local and state committees of national organizations such as the Association of Maternal and Child Health Programs, American Academy of Pediatrics and the Society for Adolescent Health and Medicine.

Providing input into pivotal federal adolescent focused initiatives such as: Healthy People 2010 and 2020 critical objectives for adolescents and young adults; HRSA/MCHB Title V adolescent focused National Performance Measures; HRSA-MCHB and OASH regional adolescent health summits for state and local public health professionals.
