Engage Our Leaders

Connect with Youth

SAHCs are conduits to youth in their states. Many SAHCs engage youth as part of program advisory and implementation groups, or have other connections with youth through grantees and vendors.

Tailor an Event or Tool for State Adolescent Health Coordinators

Tailor a tool or resource for SAHCs to improve state adolescent health programming. For example, in 2015 the Office of Adolescent Health offered a tailored webinar to share the roll-out of the Think, Act, Grow (TAG) initiative with SAHCs (a prime audience for TAG engagement).

Connect with local grantees and vendors

Many of our members have extensive relationships with vendors and their own grantees in their state. If your local grantees (or their vendors, contractors, partners, audiences) would benefit from making a connection with other adolescent health focused local grantees/programs in the state, reach out to a SAHC today!

Promote your training, event or resource

Engage a State Adolescent Health Coordinator
