- 2015 – One Page Mission/Vision and Goals...that are like what we have today
- 2017 – Overhaul to 10-page document. Incorporate Data
- 2019 - Updated

Improve quality of life and increase years of healthy life

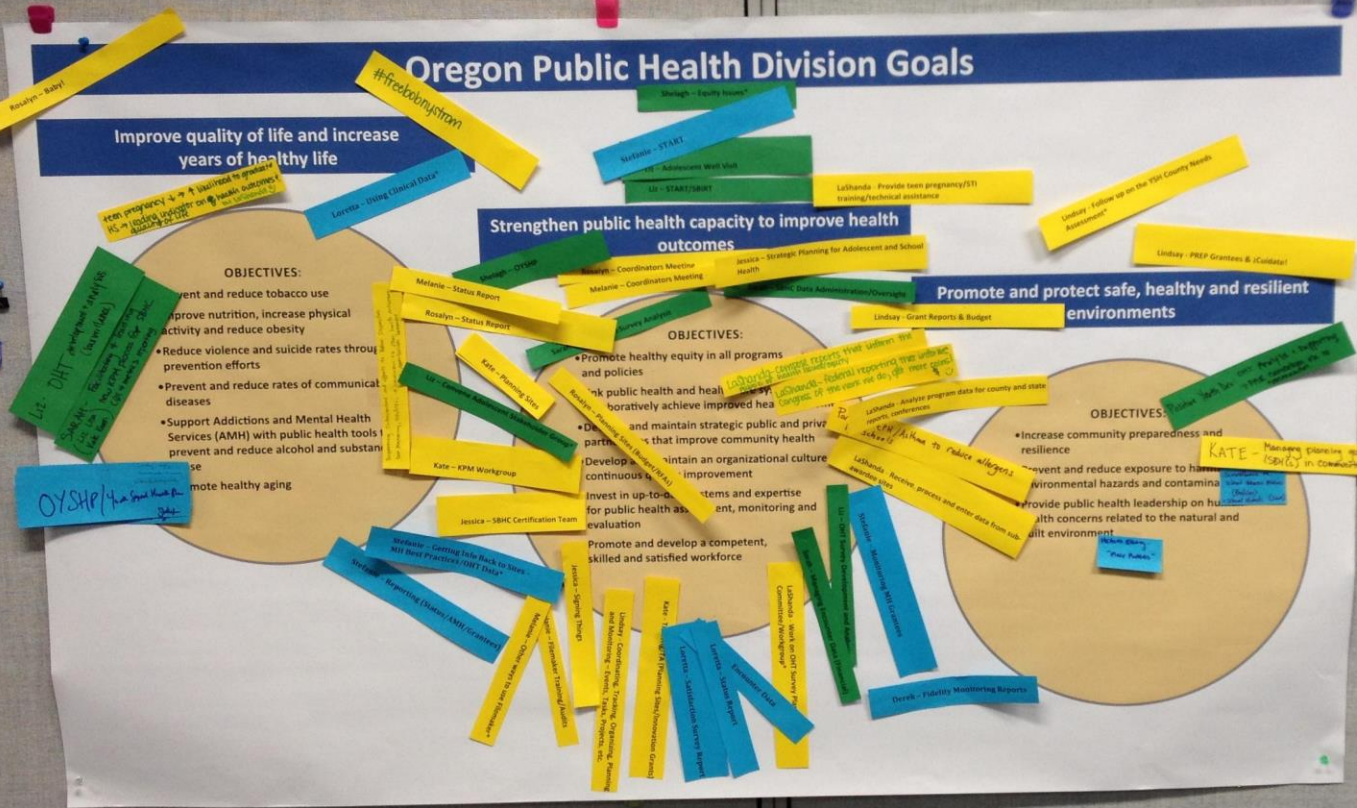
- OBJECTIVES:

Goals



- Improve access to quality health services and health education for all youth in Oregon.
- Provide partners with opportunities to build capacity, learn new information, and improve practice in order to better meet the needs of all youth in Oregon.
- Illuminate the strengths and needs of all youth in Oregon through collection, analysis and dissemination of accurate and timely data.

Staying Flexible

- Changes in Public Health Leadership, leadership's priorities, legislation, or administrative policy at the State and Federal Level
- Changes in funding
- New partnerships
- Changes in Oregon's health system, especially as it relates to the Oregon Health Plan
 - Worldwide Pandemic
 - Nationwide Anti-Racist Movement
 - Statewide Wildfires
 - All at the same time

A Two-Year Strategic Plan

- Anticipate that Vision/Mission/Goals will remain the same.
- ACTIVITIES to meet the goals are likely to change.
- Two-year cycle aligns with our state legislative and budget cycles.
- Two-year cycle encourages us to keep the plan up-to-date.

Input/Involvement/Engagement

- A&SH Strategic Plan – functional working document designed for A&SH role in agency structure
- Used for internal advocacy
- Shared with external partners – transparency
- We bring youth voice to the table when statewide plans are being created
